RULES

1. In selecting apples for exhibition, choose such specimens that would bring the highest market price. Do not select the largest. Select a medium size. On plate displays have five specimens as nearly alike as possible.
2. Each exhibitor must designate the particular premium for which he is competing in special classes, and see that the packages are properly tagged. Single specimens may not be considered or shown in variety classes.
3. The following score is to be used as a basis for the judging of all plate exhibits:

| Size (medium for variety) | 15 points |
| Color | 20 points |
| Uniformity | 25 points |
| Freedom from blemish | 30 points |
| Total | 100 points |
4. Premiums will be awarded only when the exhibit complies with the standard, is meritorious, and is properly named.
